

# Summary and Highlights from AVA Connect Call July 17, 2025, 2:00pm (ET)

Number of Attendees: 15 (22 registered)

#### **CALL HIGHLIGHTS:**

## 1. Opening Check-in

Prompt: What is your favorite summer activity?

Responses included: wearing flip flops, relaxing outdoors, spending time with family and friends, hiking, water activities, beach time, grilling, and golfing.

## 2. Open Discussion

## I. Surveys:

- Was it all done online? What about rural areas?
  - PDF or paper option for populations that may not have internet access.
- Concern about survey fatigue; recommend making the survey brief and optional.
  - Question raised: How many questions are too many?
- Opportunity for unfiltered feedback, also shared with federal partners.
- We have a dedicated research team, and they do a complete analysis on data.

#### Additional comments:

- Survey open for three months.
- Mix of open-ended and multiple-choice questions.
- Population: current subgrantees
- All online with option to request a PDF copy.
- Online allows the option for honest feedback, the only information collected is geographic region and type of organization.

# II. Status of Implementation Planning: Current Struggles, Successes and Strategies.

#### **Successes:**

- Two state team meetings completed.
- State tribal liaison is present on the team (first time in 20 years Virginia has had this level of tribal representation on the Implementation Planning Committee).

# **Challenges:**

- Administrative requirements
- Inability to provide answers to subgrantees questions.
- Allocating time for implementation planning
- Apprehension among planning team members re: how meaningful is the process—though members remain committed to the process.

# **Ideas/Strategies Shared:**

- Intentional recruitment of planning committee members,
- Shared document for committee members to give feedback to make the most use of synchronous meetings.
- Transparency with committee members and subgrantees about the state of funding.

- Reference statutory requirements whenever possible.
- "We are moving forward with business as usual," based on guidance from federal partners.

## **Additional discussion topics:**

- Impact of out-of-scope activities.
- AVA as a resource of experienced administrators for peer support.
- Administrators shared various stages of implementation planning.

**Reminder:** Continue compiling questions received from subgrantees so they can be shared with OVW during our quarterly calls.

**3. Discussion Question: "**How are folks handling conversations about the list of "trigger" words/terms?"

### Responses included:

- Lots of conversations about how to protect funding.
- Question raised: Do we need to scrub scope of work from grantees for these words/terms?
- SAAs meeting with subrecipients to ensure submitted applications comply with all federal guidance and antidiscrimination law.
- Not doing anything with it— at this point.
- Individual conversations and provide relevant support to adjust language—as needed.
- "We are using language and approaches that are in statute."
